Invitation Letter

In 2011 recycling industry has been attracting booming investment, with total annual capacity increasing by nearly 1 million tons and getting close to 8 million tons.

As a result, the flake supply gap is more perceivable, sending flake prices surging and import flake prices holding high even in off season. Meanwhile, remove of preferential VAT policies, higher public utilities charges & employment costs, and power rationing, all these are squeezing the margin of recycling companies, who are also worried by rumor about export rebate rate to be canceled.

Nevertheless, there are also some good news: regulations on importing of baled bottles and solid wastes, anti-dumping duties removed by EU, PSF futures...

To take an overall look into all those good news and bad news, we invite you to join us in the **7th China International Recycled Polyester Forum**, which is to be held during 22-23 Sep 2011. The conference is to provide valuable insights into dynamics of the polyester recycling chain, with fiber producers, traders, and suppliers of flake, equipment and finish-oil/accessory gathering together, to give opinions and exchange ideas about current market status and industry focuses:

◆ **Structure up-grading**

Recycling capacity had been expanding with economy recovering during 2009 and 2010, with business stretching toward all directions of the chain from re-PSF to re-PFY. Benefit from the cotton surge, re-PFY and H-T virgin like re-PSF are drawing growing interest.

◆ **Change of developing mode**

In 2011, economy sees a complicated picture, with China CPI staying high, inflation pressure growing and Central Bank raising deposit reserve ratio and interest rate frequently. In the world, the US's QE2 is coming to an end and bulk commodity prices are in turmoil.

In such a context, combined with squeezed margin, intensified competition and restriction in feedstock and power supply, China recycling industry will have to shift its way from extensive economic growth.
